

Making Assessments Unavailable

In practice, once you have made an assessment available, you can never make it unavailable again, for to do so will lose all student grades attached to that assessment.

Set Availability

Use Password to Control Access

If you wish to control access to your quiz, use password, which you can change without making the quiz unavailable. To do this

1. Click on the "Set Availability" Button next to your quiz in Assessment Manager.

2. Scroll down to **2 Options** and **Password Protect**:

2 Options

Show detailed result: Show your students the results for each question instead of

Reveal correct answer: Show your students the correct answer for each question. (Detailed Result checked.)

Feedback enabled: Allow your students to view the feedback that you have entered only when Show Detailed Result and Reveal Correct Answer checked.)

Allow multiple attempts: Allow your students to take this assessment multiple times

Set time for quiz: Students are shown a running clock and warned when the time is up.
Hours: 0 Minutes: 00

Password protect: Allow only those students with the specified password to take this assessment. (Leaving it blank means no password required.)

Enter password: 123 No spaces are allowed.

3. Set a password. Change this password to control access for different groups. For example, set one password for the Monday group and while they are taking the quiz, set a new password for your Thursday group. While the Thursday group is taking the quiz, set the password to something else again to deny access to all your students.
